Application for Junior Web Design Internship

About the Program. The CFY Junior Web Development Internship is a collaborative team and mentoring experience. In the program, you will learn to plan, build, debug and maintain interactive web pages. You will also learn to participate effectively on a team and develop positive workplace skills and attitudes. If selected, you will intern 10 hours/week for 6 weeks between July 8 and August 15, 2003 at CFY's office in mid-town Manhattan. During the internship, you will be mentored by college students. You will receive a certificate valued at approximately \$300 and transportation funds for your participation. Only two students (total) will be selected for the program. Both girls and boys are encouraged to apply.

How to Apply. This application includes three documents. All documents must be completed and returned to the CFY contact person at your school (see below for a list) no later than Friday, May 30.

- Document 3: **Teacher Recommendation**

Your original response to each question should be 60-200 words long. You may include graphics or other designs if you wish.

Question #1:

Please describe any activities (after-school, community, family, church...) and hobbies in which you are involved. Discuss why these activities are important to you.

Question #2:

Why would you like to be a Junior Web Design Intern at CFY and what would you like to gain from the experience? In your answer, please provide at least three reasons you would like to be in the program.

Question #3

Describe an experience in which you worked on a team. What role did you have on the team? What challenges did you face in this role? How did you overcome them? What did you learn from this team experience?
